DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To obtain optimum coverage of UpGRADE on granular fertilizers, it is APAG's recommendation that high-pressure spray be utilized. If conventional low-pressure spray is used, coverage of UpGRADE can be compromised and some of the fertilizer may not have the optimum UpGRADE coating.

Typical spray application equipment, such as a gear pump and high-pressure nozzles should be used for applying UpGRADE onto urea for even and uniform coverage. If you need information on high-pressure spray application equipment, call a spray equipment supply company.

UpGRADE is applied to Urea by the Fertilizer Dealer. UpGRADE has a 'red' dye added so that you can tell if your urea has been 'UpGRADED.' Application Recommendation for Granular Urea or Granular Urea Fertilizer Blend Only. Observe all precautions on label and read safety data sheet (SDS) before use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not store with food, or other materials to be used or consumed by humans or animals. Store in a cool, dry area. Do not contaminate water supplies, lakes, streams or ponds with this product. Replace cap and keep container closed when not in use.
