## DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For use with herbicides registered for use for agriculture, forestry, and industrial, municipal, ornamental, right-of-way, turf and non-cropland.

Prior to using **TACKLE DRA**, the user or application advisor must have experience with the combination of active ingredients or must have conducted a phytotoxicity trial.

**TACKLE DRA** may be applied by ground, CDA or aerial spray equipment.

**Ground / Aerial / Water Conditioning:** Use 2 to 4 quarts per 100 gallons of spray mixture (0.5% v/v to 1.0% v/v) when used in place of ammonium sulfate.

**For Use As a Drift Reduction Agent for XtendiMax<sup>®</sup>, Engenia<sup>®</sup>, FeXapan<sup>™</sup>-Tank Mixes:** Use 5 pints per 100 gallons in the spray mixture.

**For General Use As a Drift Reduction Agent:** Use 1 to 3 quarts per 100 gallons in the spray mixture.

**Do not use this product at a rate to exceed 1% v/v of finished spray tank mixture.**

## MIXING:

Prior to any pesticide application, all spray equipment must be thoroughly cleaned. Carefully observe all tank cleaning directions on the pesticide label. Do not mix **TACKLE DRA** with undiluted herbicides.

Unless instructed otherwise by accompanying pesticide label instructions, fill spray tank 1/2 full with water, add **TACKLE DRA** first then continue filling tank. Add remaining pesticide or nutrient ingredients consistent with respective label directions.

## GENERAL INFORMATION:

**TACKLE DRA** is a drift reduction and water conditioning agent formulated specifically for XtendiMax<sup>®</sup> tank mixes to reduce off-target drift. **TACKLE DRA** imparts a neutral pH. **TACKLE DRA** can eliminate antagonism of the spray tank caused by hard water minerals such as calcium, iron and magnesium. The surfactant ingredient in **TACKLE DRA** improves spray droplet spreading and penetration into the targeted leaf surface. **TACKLE DRA** provides humectancy to spray droplets resulting in a slower drying time for enhanced uptake of active ingredients. **TACKLE DRA** can be used for a wide range of pesticide and nutrient spray mixtures when accompanying labels recommend water conditioners and spreader-wetter adjuvants.

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## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

**Storage:** Do not store below 32° F or above 120° F. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal of this product. Store in a dry, well-ventilated space. Keep container tightly closed. Keep cool.

**Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) during mixing and loading. Do not contaminate water sources by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastewaters. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal. The Agricultural Container Recycling Council (ACRC) operates the national recycling program.
